Perhaps you already have this information but I thought I would share it with you in case you didn't. Maybe you can pass the information on. (There is no cost for the certificates)

Thank you Maureen for the information, I was unaware of the Certificates. I am writing the details below for everyone in the Gambier Bay family. I was unable to include a copy of the Certificate-but you can see it on the government website.

Here are the specifics on requesting a Memorial Certificate: A copy of the deceased veteran's military discharge document along with a copy of the death certificate must be provided when requesting a PMC. Eligible recipients, or someone acting on their behalf, may request a PMC in person at any VA Regional Office, by U.S. mail or by toll-free fax. Presidential Memorial Certificate (PMC) is a gold embossed paper certificate inscribed with the veteran's name that bears the President's signature. It honors the memory of honorably discharged deceased veterans.

History:

This program was initiated in March 1962 by President John F. Kennedy and has been continued by all subsequent Presidents.


